Escherichia coli is a rod-shaped bacterium that is found in the environment, intestines, and can also be found in food, such as lettuce and meat products. These bacteria can cause illness, but most commonly exist without causing problems. Strains of *E. coli* are also used in the scientific laboratory for experiments involving bacterial genetics.
